- I. Introduction: Read Luke 6:47-49 A solid foundation is essential for growing as a child of God. This lesson is designed to introduce obtaining and maintaining a solid foundation for your Christian life. The fruit of a healthy foundation is stability and growth through the best and worst of times. In this congregation our aim is fruitfulness for all of you that glorifies God and lasts for eternity. Said in other words, helping you become a disciple of Jesus that matures in Christ and helps others do the same. In the North Country we don't have to travel far to see buildings with sagging roofs or a shifting structure. The most common reason for these structural problems is in the foundation. It may not be deep enough, may not have been properly laid, or may not be properly maintained, resulting in significant loss.

c. Definition of <u>foundation</u>:

- i. **Greek** "something put down, to lay a basis for something to be erected"
- ii. English "ground work on which something is laid, or built;
- iii. **Application** that which is built on foundations is only as strong as the ground work.

 - i. The new birth is the beginning point

- b. Proverbs 10:25 it is an everlasting foundation 1 Timothy 6:19
- c. Matt 7:24-27 A good foundation holds together through life's storms.
- d. 2 Tim 2:19 Identifies us with God
- e. Heb 6:3 the foundation determines what can be built.
- f. Gal 4:19-20 Foundations may be laid again when necessary
